

DEEP ROOTS

A prominent Iñupiaq traditional healer from Kotzebue inspired the Della Keats program, which extends a hand to talented pre-college students—particularly students from Alaska Native or rural Alaska backgrounds who understand the needs speciec to their communities. The program gives them an insider perspective on future health-care careers. Twelve years ago, the Della Keats program merged with a closely related program, U-DOC, which also helped precollege students prepare for medical careers. The Alaska WWAMI School of Medical Education—Alaska's medical school—runs this merged program. Students in it can explore careers in medicine, medical research, nursing and public health.
