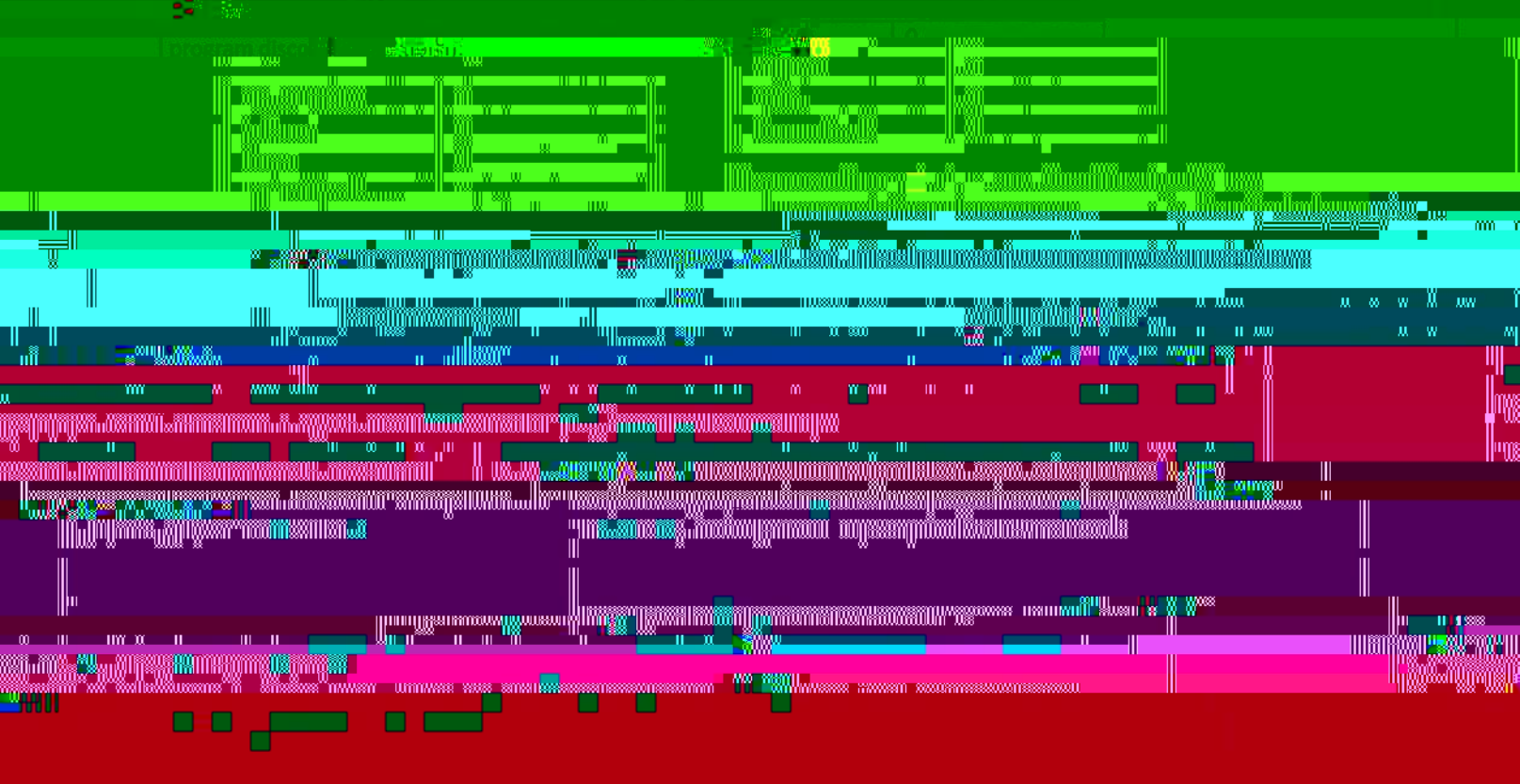
Dear John:
